All persons who wish to serve as Election Commissioners are invited to attend a school for commissioners which will be held:

You must only attend one class. The building will open thirty minutes before each class.

**ALL PERSONS INTERESTED IN BEING AN ELECTION COMMISSIONER, MUST POSSESS THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATIONS:**

- ✓ Qualified voter, not entitled to assistance in voting;
- ✓ Can be 17 years old in 12th grade;
- ✓ Not a candidate in the election or a child, child's spouse, brother, brother's spouse, sister, sister's spouse, parent, spouse, or parents of the spouse of candidate in precinct where serving;
- ✓ Registered to vote in ward serving unless replacements are necessary;
- ✓ Not have been convicted of an election offense;
- ✓ Successfully completed training;
- ✓ Not a law enforcement officer.
- ✓ Attend training and pass at least 10 questions of a 15 question test.

**CERTIFICATES FOR PERSONS COMPLETING THE COURSE OF INSTRUCTION WILL BE VALID FROM THE DATE OF THE SCHOOL UNTIL JUNE 30, 2020.**
